

Civilian Code of Conduct

The Valor Games Far West values your participation as a volunteer and/or spectator. During the event, I understand that each of us represent not only ourselves and our communities, but also Veterans, the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Northern California Paralympic Regional Sport program, Far West Wheelchair Athletic Association, as well as the host hotel. I understand it is a privilege to be involved in the Valor Games.

I understand that if I am found in violation of the Code of Conduct, I may be immediately asked to leave the event. Depending on the type of violation, I may be prohibited from involvement in future Valor Games events, and/or involvement with affiliated organizations.

I must agree to abide by the Valor Games Far West Civilian Code of Conduct as detailed below.

- 1. I understand that I am subject to a background check.
- 2. I will behave in a professional, courteous, and respectful manner toward fellow community members, staff, volunteers, and event spectators.
- 3. I understand that no form of abuse or harassment, whether it is verbal, physical, emotional or sexual, will be tolerated.
- 4. I understand that Coast Guard Island is an active military base, and I am subject to the rules and regulations as posted by Coast Guard Officials.
- 5. I will completely abstain from the consumption of alcohol or illegal substances during the VGFW.
- 6. I will respect all property at the event and I understand that I am responsible for any damage that I cause.
- 7. I will abide by all posted rules and regulations.
- 8. I will abide by the decisions of the Organizing Committee.
- 9. If I am not able to attend the Valor Games, and my presence is relied on, I will contact the event staff via email or phone ASAP.
